Eligibility criteria:

For Orange Knowledge Programme Scholarships:

- There is **no age limit**;
- The candidate must be a national of, and working and living in, one of the following countries on the <u>OKP country list;</u>
- The candidate must not be employed by an organisation that has its own means of staff development, for example:
 - o multinational corporations (e.g. Shell, Unilever, Microsoft),
 - o large national and/or large commercial organisations,
 - bilateral donor organisations (e.g. USAID, DFID, Danida, Sida, Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs, FinAid, AusAid, ADC, SwissAid),
 - multilateral donor organisations, (e.g. a UN organisation, the World Bank, the IMF, Asian Development Bank, African Development Bank, IADB),
 - international NGO's (e.g. Oxfam, Plan, Care).
- The candidate must have a current Employer Statement;
- The candidate must have a passport that is valid at least 4 months after the application deadline;
- The candidate must not apply for more than one scholarship for courses that take place at the same time;
- The short courses are taught in English. Therefore, it is important that **your English language skills** (writing and speaking) are good; and
- Minimum of two years relevant work experience is required, working with of for local or regional authorities, civil society organisations, local or regional NGOs etc. It is to your advantage if the work/experience is related to the content of the training.

For MENA Scholarship Programme:

- You must meet the ALL the same requirements as mentioned above for Orange Knowledge Programme Scholarships;
- You must **not be over 45 years of age on the application deadline + 2 weeks** (this only applies for MSP Scholarships applications);
- You must be a national of, and working and living in one of the countries on the following <u>MSP country list</u> valid at the time of application; and
- The candidate must have a valid passport that is valid on the application deadline (+ 2 weeks).

About your eligibility

If your application does not meet the eligibility criteria it will be rejected regardless of any effort, time and money you put into it.
